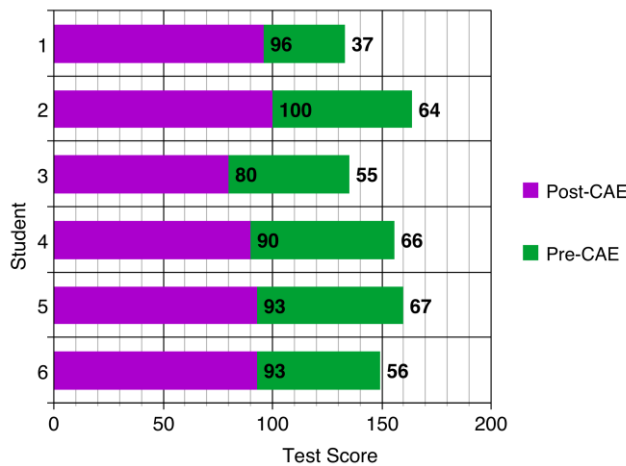

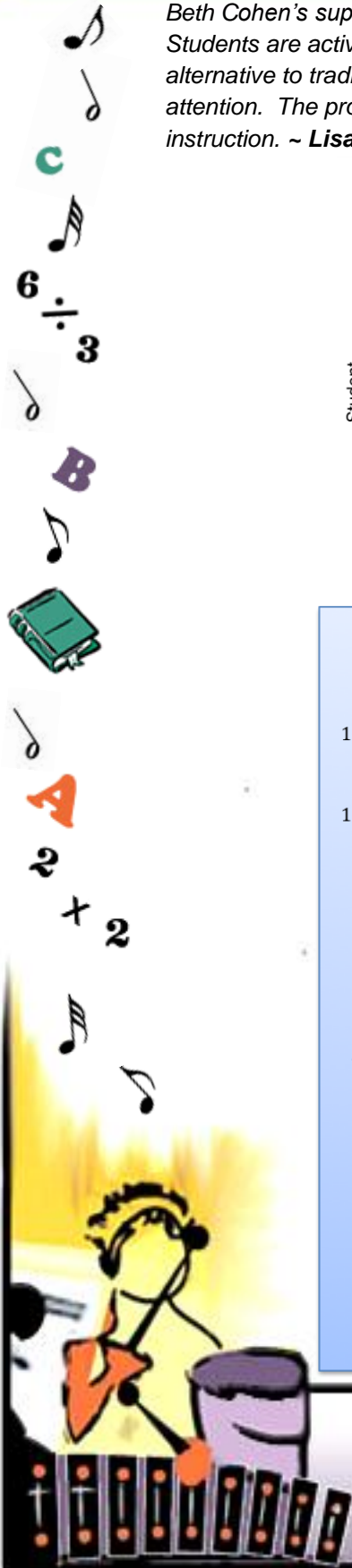
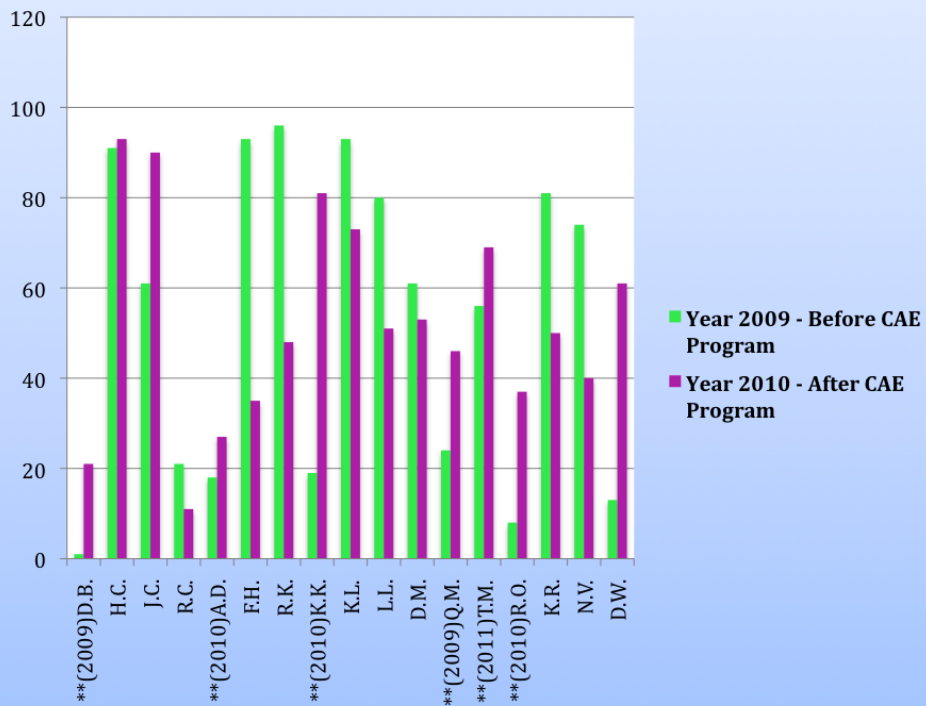

## JCPS #20 Maggio K/1st Grade 2009-2010 NJ State Terranova Testing Results



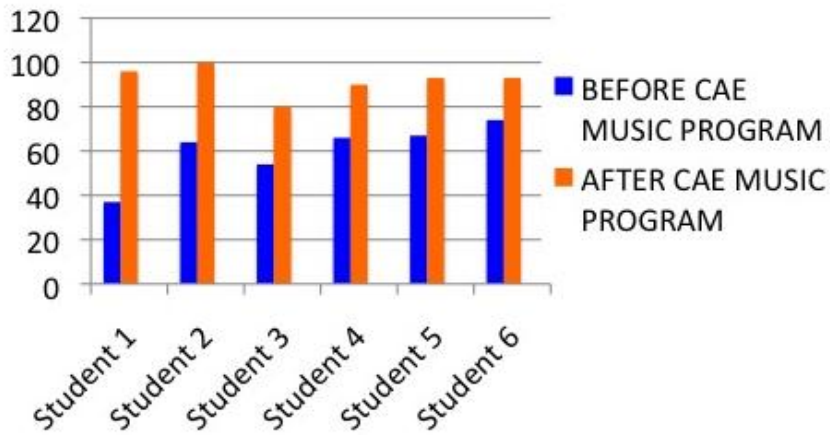
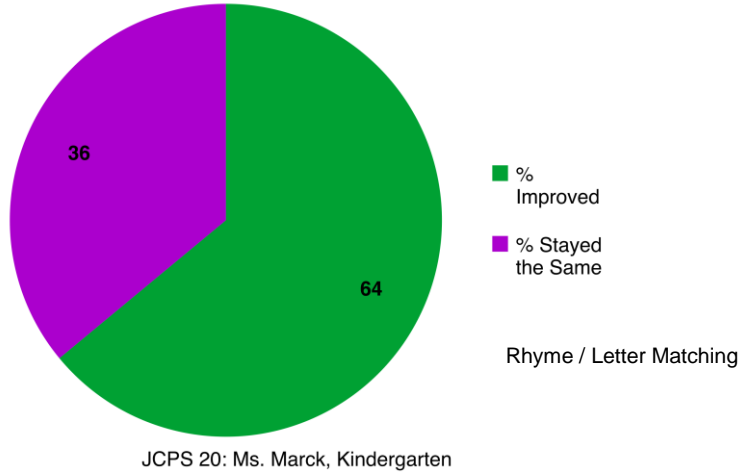


# Testing Results
